GENERAL INFORMATION

Description: Repels mosquitoes. Mosquito Barrier is a concentrated garlic juice solution that is sprayed on plants, shrubs, and turf to repel mosquitoes. Odourless in hours.

How it works: Mosquitoes are repelled by the odour of Mosquito Barrier almost immediately after spraying.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

DO NOT contaminate irrigation or drinking water supplies or aquatic habitats by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes.

Remove all areas of standing water. Shake well before using. Product will empty quickly from bottle so plan your spray pattern. Ensure sprayer is set to the "OFF" position prior to attaching to a garden hose. Connect HOSE END SPRAYER to garden hose, then turn water supply on at the source. To apply product, turn sprayer valve to "On". Spray foliage until run-off. When spraying is complete, turn the sprayer valve to the "WATER" position. Flush with water to clean the sprayer head, then turn the control valve to the "OFF" position (note: "WATER" position is to be used only for cleaning sprayer head.). Turn water supply off. Disconnect hose from applicator and store remaining product in original container. For best results spray in early morning or early evening; avoid spraying in the heat of day and in windy conditions Use in areas that attract mosquitoes, such as grass, plants, shrubs and under decks and porches.

Garlic juice may cause marking of some plants or surfaces. Apply to small area or individual plants to determine compatibility. Re-apply after heavy rain or if mosquitoes continue to be a problem.

PRECAUTIONS KEEP OUT OF REACH OF CHILDREN Do not swallow. Avoid getting on skin and in eyes. May cause skin and eye irritation. Avoid inhaling/breathing mist or vapours. Potential skin sensitizer. Apply only when the potential for drift is minimal. Individuals who are sensitive or allergic to garlic should avoid handling Mosquito Barrier. Individuals who are sensitive or allergic to garlic should avoid treated areas until dry or after a heavy rain. Do not spray on Blue Spruce trees.

FIRST AID

If swallowed: Call a poison control centre or doctor immediately for treatment advice. Have person sip a glass of water if able to swallow. Do not induce vomiting unless told to do so by a poison control centre or doctor. Do not give anything by mouth to an unconscious person. **If on skin or clothing:** Take off contaminated clothing. Rinse skin immediately with plenty of water for 15–20 minutes. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice.

If inhaled: Move person to fresh air. If person is not breathing, call 911 or an ambulance, then give artificial respiration, preferably by mouth-to-mouth, if possible. Call a poison control centre or doctor for further treatment advice. **If in eyes:** Hold eye open and rinse slowly and gently with water for 15–20 minutes.

Remove contact lenses, if present, after the first 5 minutes, then continue rinsing eye. Call a poison control centre or doctor for treatment advice. Take container, label or product name and Pest Control Product Registration Number with you when seeking medical attention.

TOXICOLOGICAL INFORMATION Treat symptomatically.

STORAGE To prevent contamination store this product away from food or feed.

DISPOSAL DO NOT reuse the empty containers. Dispose of empty container in household garbage.
